Frequently Asked Questions

Are charges mandatory?

During your funded hours there are no mandatory charges. The meal and activity costs are voluntary, based on whether or not you wish your child to access these. During privately paid hours meals and activity charges are mandatory.

Can my child bring food from home instead of paying for meals?

Whilst we strongly encourage parents to access our home cooked meals which have been developed to ensure that your child receives a well balanced diet in line with government requirements, you are able to bring food from home providing it is fully in line with our Nutrition and Mealtimes policy found on our website. You must identify this on your funding form and can only opt in or out of the arrangement at the start of each term, giving at least 4 weeks' notice. Meal costs will still apply during any private hours even if meals from home are provided.

Is there a registration fee payable?

If you are taking any privately paid care, then a registration fee of £100 is payable. If you are only taking funded hours then no fee is due.

Are there any discounts available?

If you have more than 1 child enrolled, you will receive a sibling discount of 5% on your fees.

If you work for Toyota, Rolls Royce, Bombardier or any NHS service then you will receive 5% discount. Please bring proof of employment with your registration documents. Only one discount can be applied at any time.

What happens to my funded hours if my child is absent or the nursery is closed?

If your child is absent for a reason such as illness, appointment or holiday then you will forfeit any funding on those days. If you attend on a 38 week package it is expected that you take holidays in the weeks that your child does not attend. Please note that should your child be absent for a holiday for more than 2 funded weeks, then the Local Authority must be informed, and you are at risk of losing your funded place.

The nursery closes for Bank Holidays and any funded hours allocated to these days can be taken on another day within the same calendar month. Please speak to the nursery manager should you wish to arrange this.

How do I apply for funded hours?

Please visit <https://childcare.beststartinlife.gov.uk/> to check your eligibility for funding.

If you are entitled to 30 hours working parent funding, you will be given an 11 digit code which you will need to revalidate every 3 months. If you are eligible for 2 year old Flying Start funding, you will be given a 5 digit code from the local authority which does not need revalidation.

All children are entitled to 15 hours funding from the term after they turn 3 years old.

All parents need to complete a funding form, available from the nursery, to request a funded place and indicate if you are paying for meals and activities. This will only need to be completed again should you wish to change your child's attendance pattern, opt into/out of meals or you gain/lose funded hours.
